

PBIS Year 2: Aligning Classroom Practices with Universal (Tier 1) School-wide Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support

PBIS is a framework that meets the requirements of Ohio Revised Code 3301-35-15 (Effective 8/1/2013) *Standards for the implementation of positive behavior intervention supports and the use of restraint and seclusion*, and *Ohio Department of Education Policy on Positive Behavior Interventions and Restraint and Seclusion* adopted 1/15/2013.

This train-the-trainer session is intended for the leadership team which attended SST 12's PBIS three-part series presented in 2013-2014.

PBIS identifies eight effective classroom skills and practices that have been shown to increase the likelihood of appropriate behavior and decrease problem behavior. As a result, academic learning time and ultimately student achievement is increased for all students. This one-day training will provide your training team with the tools to implement the universal tier at the classroom level.
