

PBIS Year 2:

Aligning Classroom Practices with Universal (Tier 1) School-wide Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support

PBIS is a framework that meets the requirements of Ohio Revised Code 3301-35-15 (Effective 8/1/2013) Standards for the implementation of positive behavior intervention supports and the use of restraint and seclusion, and Ohio Department of Education Policy on Positive Behavior Interventions and Restraint and Seclusion adopted 1/15/2013.

This train-the-trainer session is intended for the leadership team which attended SST 12's PBIS three-part series presented in 2013-2014.

PBIS identifies eight effective classroom skills and practices that have been shown to increase the likelihood of appropriate behavior and decrease problem behavior. As a result, academic learning time and ultimately student achievement is increased for all students. This one-day training will provide your training team with the tools to implement the universal tier at the classroom level.
